

Care Guide Outdoor



A little care goes
a long way.



Your outdoor pieces are made to be used outside, but regular, simple maintenance will help them look their best for longer.

- ✓ If the furniture gets wet after rain or snowfall, wipe it dry promptly to prevent surface damage over time.
- ✓ Remove stains as soon as possible and wipe off bird droppings before they can leave permanent marks.
- ✓ During winter, store the furniture in a cool, dry place or keep it covered so snow or rain does not come into contact with the surface.
- ✓ When moving the furniture, lift it rather than pulling or pushing it to avoid damaging the floor, legs, and mountings.
- ✓ Make sure the furniture is completely dry before winter storage.
- ✓ Use protective mats under damp, hot, or coloured objects to help prevent permanent marks.

Wooden furniture

Our wooden outdoor furniture is made of solid pine wood, properly dried for outdoor use and finished with an outdoor-grade lacquer.

- Use a soft microfiber cloth with lukewarm water and a small amount of mild dish soap. Always wipe dry.
- Do not use abrasive tools (rough sponges, scouring pads, wire brushes).
- Avoid aggressive chemicals such as alcohol, ammonia, acetone, chlorine, or products with microgranules – they can dull, scratch, or damage the lacquer over time.
- Consider using specialist care products for lacquered softwood (available commercially), as recommended for regular maintenance.
- During heavy rain, we recommend keeping the furniture under a roof or umbrella when possible.
- Do not stand on the table or benches and do not rock on them – this can bend the legs and may cause an accident.
- Check all screws regularly and tighten them after the first few weeks of use.

Steel furniture

Our steel outdoor furniture is protected with a zinc layer and finished with a textured powder coating, designed to improve resistance to knocks and scratches.

- Clean with a soft cloth and gentle cleaning agents only.
- Avoid contact with solvents, ammonia, corrosive substances, and strongly staining liquids, as they may damage the surface.

Outdoor Cushions

Our cushions are made from materials that are suitable for outdoor conditions, but we recommend storing them away during rain for best longevity.

- Bring cushions indoors during rain whenever possible.
- After rain, hang cushions to dry in a well-ventilated, dry place before using again.
- During winter, store cushions in a cool, dry place (or under cover) and make sure they are completely dry before storage.
- Clean gently with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Do not wring or twist.
- Do not machine wash.
- Do not iron.
- Do not bleach (including chlorine bleach).
- Do not wring or twist.
- Do not tumble dry.
- Do not dry clean.
- Hang to dry (line dry).
