RUG CARE GUIDE

To keep your rug looking its best for as long as possible we have created some top tips on how to care for your new synthetic fibre rug

Synthetic Fibre - good to know

Synthetic yarns such as polyester and polypropylene are highly durable and crafted using finely hand-spun yarns that are easy-care, vacuum friendly and resistant to moisture and resistant to spills.

Un-rolling your rug

To help your rug lay flat, re-roll your rug pile out and leave in a warm room for 24 hours. This will help reduce any wrinkles from packing.

Day to day care

Everyday dust and dirt are easy to clean from a polyester/polypropylene rug. Simply shake or beat your rug to dislodge any debris and gently vacuum with the nozzle attachment.

Loose ends

Snip any loose fibres carefully with scissors - never pull.

Safety first

Add an anti-slip underneath your rug to prevent the rug from slipping.

Spills

Act fast and blot liquid spills immediately. Spot clean as needed with a dampened white cloth only. If the stain remains use a mild detergent to blot the area or gently rub until the stain lifts.

Long term care

Rotate every 3 months to avoid uneven fading and wear.



WE RECOMMEND
An anti-slip mat will help prevent slipping.



SUCTION VAC
Use a suction type vacuum - rotating brushes may damage this rug.



EASY CARE
Blot spills immediately with a clean, dry white cloth. **Do not rub.**
